Governor Reynolds Releases Budget Proposal

- Known in the budget as the Commercial and Industrial Property Tax
 Replacement Claim, Governor Reynolds has proposed to fund the entire
 \$152 million backfill appropriation for FY 22.
- Other priorities in the proposed budget include broadband investment, increased access to child care, expansion of housing options and continuing public-private partnerships.
